Writing Prompt Suggestions for the 2019 YAF Writing Contest

We encourage you to be creative with the ways you think about the contest theme **experiencing something unexpected!** It's often helpful to read the book associated with the contest to think about how it could inspire your writing. This year's featured book is *The Colored Car* by Jean Alcia Elster. If you're not sure how to get started, consider some of these suggestions, but feel free to come up with your own. Inspiration can come from anywhere!

An unexpected find:

- Finding or coming across a stray dog, cat, or other animal.
- Finding a wallet or a large sum of money.
- Meeting someone who ends up becoming very important to you.
- Meeting a new friend at school.
- Finding out something about your or a friend's family, family member, or family history that you didn't know before.

An unexpected move:

- Having to move to another neighborhood, city, state, or country.
- Switching to a different school.

Unexpected changes or adjustments:

- Becoming a big sister or brother.
- Having to change or make adjustments because of an injury or health condition (yours or someone else close to you).

Unexpected travel experiences:

• Send a letter home to someone describing your experience of a new place or of a culture very different from yours.
